## TEMPORARY USE PERMIT APPLICATION

### RECREATIONAL VEHICLES

Recreational vehicles placed on sites within all unnumbered and numbered A zones and AE Zones in Lincoln County Floodplain are required to be on the site for **fewer** than 180 consecutive days and be fully licensed and ready for highway use. \*

Recreational vehicles must meet the permitting, elevation and anchoring requirements under manufactured homes in the Lincoln County Floodplain Management Ordinance.

*\*A recreational vehicle is ready for highway use if it is on its wheels or jacking system, is attached to the site only by quick-disconnect type utilities and security devices, and has no permanently attached additions.*

### GENERAL PROCEDURES

1. Submit application to allow the temporary use of the unit on the site. One application per unit. Placement of the RV on the site may NOT occur until after the Temporary Use Permit application has been approved and the Temporary Use Permit has been issued. No occupancy or use of the RV is permitted until the Permit has been issued. The permit must be placed inside a window so that is visible from the road.
2. On the back of the application form draw the parcel or lot showing the location of the RV placement on the property
3. Provide License Plate number or copy of Registration.
4. PERMIT EXPIRATION: The permit will automatically expire 180 days from the date of issuance. Another Temporary Use Permit must be obtained before the expiration of the initial Permit. Call 636-528-6182 for new permit.

The Temporary Use Permit may be canceled for non-compliance with the conditions set forth in approving the permit and/or as specified in the Lincoln County Floodplain Ordinance.

**FAILURE TO RENEW THE TEMPORARY USE PERMIT OR REMOVE THE RECREATIONAL VEHICLE AT THE END OF THE APPROVED TIME PERIOD WILL RESULT IN LEGAL ACTION TO REMOVE THE RV. ANY COST INCURRED BY THE COUNTY TO REMOVE THE RV SHALL BE BILLED TO THE APPLICANT.**
